DARRELL FLOYD

In the early 1950's Darrell Floyd lit up the tiny gymnasium at Fair Grove High School with amazing offensive displays. After gaining All State recognition, he attended Furman University. Even though teamed with NBA great Frank Selvy, Darrell played second to no one, leading the NCAA in scoring in 1954-1955 with a 35.9 average. The 1955-1956 season saw him lead the college ranks again with a 33.9 average. A true All American, Darrell's career 32.1 average still ranks No. 8 on the all time NCAA record book.
