Doug was named the county's leading male athlete in 1971. He excelled in four sports at West Davidson High. Starting with basketball, track, baseball and football, he was a leader in all. His main achievements came in football. He was the first player in Davidson County to be named for the Shrine Bowl. As a backfield ace for the Green Dragons he scored 134 points with 19 touchdowns. He was a placement kicker, and a rusher at 6.3 yards per carry. He was a pass receiver, a punter (39.8 avg.), and a punt returner.

The college coaches summed him up as the best all around back within a 20 school area. Doug absolutely was an amazing player to watch in any sport that was in season. He was a leading rebounder and scorer during the basketball seasons. He was always willing to sacrifice any personal glory for the good of the team. As for track, he was a leader in the 440 and 100 yard dash. West would not allow a player to play more than one sport at a time, so he passed up baseball to run track. Of course he did play baseball with the American Legion team. Doug went to Florida State, where he also played football, lettering as a Freshman.
