# HAROLD CARTER

Harold Carter received national recognition for his accomplishments on the gridiron beginning in high school. Although remembered for his exploits on the football field, he starred in baseball and basketball in high school. It was in football that he shone like few others. As a quarterback, he made All State and All American. He starred in North Carolina's 20-6 win in the annual Shrine Bowl. He continued to star at Catawba College where he was named All American in 1952. He was All Conference for two years and was the only small college player named to the UPI All State Team. In 1954, he served as team captain and garnered the MVP award. On graduation he moved into coaching and won the Rocky River Conference Coach of the Year award three times. He retired in 1989.
