JUNE SHOAF BOOZE “Miss Hook Shot”

June lit up all the lights at Reeds High School with an incredible “hook shot” that made her an outstanding basketball player from 1949 to 1952. She was a starter for Hall of Fame coach Roy Swicegood. The

sensational Miss Shoaf piled up a great record as a star player who could shoot her famous hook shot with either hand. She rounded out her high school career with a 25 point average, scoring over 800 points in her senior year. She was Captain of the “All County” team in 1952, All State 2nd team in 1951, and 1st team All State in 1952. She had a high game of 52 points. June played for Virgil Yow with Hanes Hosiery for two years. In 1953 they won the National Championship in Wichita.
