At Lexington Senior High, V. G. was All-Conference, All-State, and All-Southern, earning a scholarship to Duke University. He also played on the basketball and baseball teams in high school. V. G. attended Catawba College after a three year hitch in WWII. At Catawba, he was a member of the 1947 Tangerine Bowl team that defeated Marshall University 7-0. They had an 11-0 record that year. The following year they defeated Maryville 31-0 in the same bowl game. V. G. was head football coach in Elkin and in Lexington. He was also assistant coach at Lexington. He also coached baseball, track and field, wrestling, golf and tennis. He was a teacher at LSHS for 33 years and coached for 25 years. V. G. served on the Lexington City Council for 28 years, served as Mayor for five years and was the Chamber of Commerce "Man of the Year". He was highly respected.
